Pan-Canadian Accord Policy

WHEREAS the Council of Alberta University Students believes in a quality public postsecondary education system that is properly funded, effective and accountable, cooperatively maintained and enhanced by the provincial and federal governments; and

WHEREAS the Council of Alberta University Students' vision for post-secondary education is that Albertans will have a publicly funded post-secondary system that encourages student mobility and that is accessible, affordable, and of the highest quality; and

WHEREAS both the provincial and federal governments have a responsibility for funding and ensuring the well being of Canada's post-secondary education system; and

WHEREAS the Council of Alberta University Students believes that the Government of Alberta must work with the federal government and other provincial governments to form a strong and long-lasting partnership that will improve and preserve the quality and public integrity of our public post-secondary institutions.

BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Council of Alberta University Students advocate to the Government of Alberta to enter negotiations with the federal and other provincial governments to establish a Pan-Canadian Accord.
