Campus Alberta Quality Council Policy
Policy #04-14

WHEREAS the Campus Alberta Quality Council has been created with the mandate to provide information and advice to the Minister on matters pertaining to the accreditation and co-ordination of degree programs in Alberta; and

WHEREAS students are primary stakeholders in post-secondary education, and that student input is valuable in constructing comprehensive policies affecting post-secondary education; and

BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Council of Alberta University Students recommend to the Ministry of Advanced Education that the Campus Alberta Quality Council include permanent student representatives.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT the Council of Alberta University Students urge that when accreditation is granted on the basis of sharing resources with other institutions, such as libraries, that adequate funding is provided to ensure that those resources are able to meet the needs of all institutions.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT the Council of Alberta University Students recommend that the Campus Alberta Quality Council and the Alberta Council and Admissions and Transfer (ACAT) work in concert to ensure that all students transferring within the post-secondary system meet the minimum standards of academic standards of the admitting institution.
